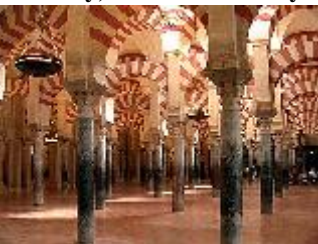

Saturday, October 16 - Day 1 - DEPART - This afternoon we leave New York, JFK on our way to Malaga via a European gateway.

Sunday, October 17 - Day 2 – MALAGA - Upon arrival in Malaga we meet our Unitours Tour Manager and transfer to our lovely hotel in Torremolinos, along the beautiful “Costa del Sol”. The rest of the day is free. Dinner and overnight at the hotel.

Monday, October 18 - Day 3 - CORDOBA - Departure for Cordoba, passing Antequera. After a brief stop we'll continue our trip. On arrival to this unique town, known in the whole world for its Arab and Jewish monuments and sights, including the Mosque, Jewish Quarter, Synagogue, and the Roman bridge. Lunch on your



own, followed by a sightseeing tour of the typical Patios and gardens of Cordoba. Afterwards return to Costa del Sol. Dinner and overnight at the hotel.

Tuesday, October 19 - Day 4 - SEVILLE - Departure in the morning for Seville. On arrival a full panoramic sightseeing tour of the city, including the Santa Cruz Quarter, Maria Luisa Park, Avenue of the Palm Trees, area surrounding the Expo and the entrance to the



Cathedral. It is one of the world's most beautiful Gothic temples; the dimensions of this cathedral make it one of the largest Gothic churches in the world and the third largest in all of Christendom. Afterwards return to the Costa del Sol. Dinner and overnight at the hotel.

Wednesday, October 20 - Day 5 – MIJAS/RONDA - Mijas, a very small village of about 9000 inhabitants, situated at 460 meters above sea-level so picturesque with its narrow and white washed streets and its friendly people. From its balcony one can admire the wonderful panorama of Fuengirola, Carvajal and Los Boliches. The bullring (the only square one in Spain) was built during arab domination. In the afternoon we will proceed to Ronda. On arrival sightseeing tour of this beautiful Andalusian town of Celtic origin, with the Cathedral (roman, Arabic and gothic styles), the old quarter, the bull ring (oldest

one in Spain) and the Tajo. Return to the hotel for dinner and overnight.

Thursday, October 21 - Day 6 – GRANADA - Departure in the morning to Riofrío, where we make a short stop. Afterwards



we proceed to Granada to visit the Alhambra, a famous fortress and supreme monument of Arabic architecture and the gorgeous Gardens of the Generalife, enjoying the suggestive panoramic view of the City and Gipsy

Quarters of the Albaicín. Lunch, free time and return by the same route. Dinner and overnight at the hotel

Friday, October 22 - Day 7 – NERJA/FRIGILIANA - Drive along the attractive road bordering the sea and crossing several white villages with a stop at the beautiful little village of Frigiliana, where you will find all the essence of Andalusia. Arrival to Nerja. Visit of the prehistorical cave of impressive dimensions where the various halls and galleries can be admired. Free time to enjoy the beautiful view from the terrace. Return to the hotel for dinner and overnight.

Saturday, October 23 - Day 8 - GIBRALTAR - Drive along the coastal road to Gibraltar. Gibraltar dominates the entrance to the Mediterranean between the southern tip of Spain and the continent of Africa. Both famous and enigmatic, Gibraltar contains some of the most extensive military fortifications in Europe, spanning over 1200 years of Moorish, Spanish and British history. Enjoy a tour of the city, tunnel and Punta Europa by minibus followed by a minibus tour of the rock itself, the Saint Michael caves and monkey reserve before making the most of your free time for shopping. Return to the hotel for dinner and overnight.

Sunday, October 24 - Day 9 – RETURN – Today we make our way back to New York, JFK with memories of a lifetime.
