**Saturday, September 18 Day 1 –
Depart New York**

Today we depart for Munich from New York, JFK.

**Sunday, September 19 - Day 2 –
Arrive Munich**

Transfer by private coach from Munich Airport to Prien am Chiemsee. At the airport we will be met and assisted by our tour manager for the week. Room assignments at the Hotel Bayerischer Hof (our residence for the week) and short walking tour of Prien am Chiemsee, including the Museum of Chiemgau and Prien traditions. Welcoming Drinks at 7.00 p.m. Dinner at 7.30 p.m.

**Monday, September 20 - Day 3 –
Excursion to Regensburg**

Depart for Regensburg. Enjoy a guided tour of the 2000 year old former Roman City with its old City Hall, Cathedral, Stone Bridge and the famous “Wurstkuchl”. Lunch on your own. On the way back we stop in Freising at the Cathedral where Pope Benedict XVI was ordained and subsequently became Bishop. Dinner and overnight at hotel.

Tuesday, September 21 - Day 4 – Excursion to Munich

Depart for Dachau/Munich. Visit and tour the concentration camp of Dachau. Lunch on your own. Take city tour of the more famous sights of Germany’s most prosperous city, Munich. Shop in the famous Ludwig and Maximiliansstrasse. Visit and enjoy the Oktoberfest. Dinner on your own at the Oktoberfest. Return to our hotel for overnight.

Wednesday, September 22 - Day 5 – Excursion to Salzburg

Depart for Salzburg, home town of Wolfgang Amadeus Mozart. During the city-walk in Salzburg see and visit the birth place of W. A. Mozart, the Salzburg Cathedral and St. Peters Abbey. Lunch on your own. Free time for shopping. In early evening, dinner at the Sternbräu Restaurant. Attend a special Mozart concert celebrating his 250th Birthday in the 900 year old Fortress Hohensalzburg, the landmark of Salzburg. Return to our hotel for overnight.



Thursday, September 23 - Day 6 – Excursion to Innsbruck and the Swarovski Crystal World

Depart for the Swarovski Crystal World in Wattens with free time for shopping. Continue to Innsbruck with time for lunch on your own. Walking tour of Innsbruck, the Tyrolean capital. Return to our hotel for dinner and overnight.

**Friday, September 24 - Day 7 –
Excursion to Neuschwanstein Castle**

Depart for the fairy-tale King’s Castle of Neuschwanstein. Admire the breathtaking architecture of the Castle and tour the most popular of all the palaces and castles in Europe. Return to our hotel for dinner and overnight.

**Saturday, September 25 - Day 8 –
Excursion to the Chiemgau and Chiemsee Region**

Depart for an excursion through the beautiful Chiemgau Region. Travel by bus to the pier and then enjoy a short boat journey to the

Island of Herrenchiemsee. Tour the New Castle Ludwig II “Herrenchiemsee”. Visit the museum in the Augustinian Monastery where the conference was held to prepare the Constitution of the Federal Republic of Germany. Continue by boat to the “Fraueninsel” with a short walk to the Cathedral and the Convent St. Irmgard. Lunch on your own. On the island observe old pottery handcrafts and have time for shopping. Return by boat and bus to our hotel for dinner and overnight.

Sunday, September 26 - Day 9 – Transfer to Munich Airport for New York, JFK

Depart Munich today. Arrive New York, JFK this afternoon with wonderful memories of our stay in Bavaria.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

TOTAL TOUR PRICE: The tour price is based on airfare, cruise, land rates and rates of exchange in effect July 8, 2009. All rates are subject to change without prior notice. Should the rates go up or down, an adjustment would be made prior to departure. No refunds for any accommodations, services or events that are not used. If fewer than 20 passengers participate a price adjustment may be necessary.

PASSPORT AND VISA REQUIREMENTS: At the time of printing, U.S. citizens holding valid passports DO NOT REQUIRE visas or immunization for the country or countries being visited. Citizens of countries other than U.S. - MUST contact the consulate of the country or countries being visited to determine visa requirements.

AIR TRANSPORTATION: International flight reservations are being held on Air France. No stopovers are permitted. Any changes after ticket is issued, carries a mandatory charge of \$200. Once the tickets are issued, they are NON REFUNDABLE. Additional non-recoverable airline penalties of up to \$200 may be assessed for cancellations received within 90 days of departure

DOMESTIC AIRFARE: For those who make domestic air arrangements to the originating city of this tour, we strongly recommend the purchase of tickets that can be changed without heavy fees and penalties as international flight schedules are always subject to change.

HOTEL ACCOMMODATIONS: Specially selected hotels based on twin occupancy with private bath. Single Room supplement of \$276 will be charged where requested and available. If you do not have a roommate and Unitours is unable to arrange one, you will be billed for the single room supplement. All singles are subject to availability.

MEALS: Breakfast and Table D' Hote dinners are provided daily except where noted in the itinerary. An extra charge will be made when coffee, tea or other beverages are not included in the menu of the day with the dinner meal.

TIPS AND TAXES: Tips and taxes normally appearing on hotel and restaurant bills as service are included, as are all government and local taxes, hotel portage of one suitcase per person if hotel provides such service. One average sized suitcase not exceeding 50 lbs total weight and 62 linear inches (height plus width plus depth) is permitted throughout the trip.

INTERNATIONAL DEPARTURE TAXES OF \$133 plus current fuel surcharges of \$180 ARE NOT INCLUDED NOR ARE TIPS TO TOUR MANAGER/GUIDES, DRIVERS OR DINING ROOMS STAFF.

NOT INCLUDED: Expenses and items not specifically mentioned in this brochure are NOT covered, including but not limited to: passport and visa fees, meals not listed and items of a personal nature such as laundry, wines, liquors, mineral waters, after dinner coffee or tea,

sightseeing or services other than those specifically mentioned, tips and taxes mentioned above, excess baggage and insurance, etc.

DEPOSITS AND CANCELLATIONS: A deposit of \$300 is required to secure reservations. Any balance is to be paid in full no later than 60 days before departure of tour. Final payments received by Unitours within 45 days prior to departure must include a \$25 late payment fee. Reservations made within 60 days of departure must include full payment. Amex, Visa and Mastercard are accepted with signed reservation form. Final payments will be applied to same credit card on final payment due date. Cancellations made from time of reservation to within 61 days prior to departure -- \$100 processing charge plus any air penalties noted above. In the event of a cancellation from 60 to 8 days of departure --\$150 processing charge plus up to 50% of the land cost, plus any air penalties noted above. No refund for cancellations received within 7 days of departure. All cancellation and refund claims must be in writing to Unitours, Inc.

DEVIATIONS: A service charge of \$50 pp will be applied for any deviations made in tour, (where possible), PLUS any additional air or land charges incurred.

LAND ARRANGEMENTS: The tour operator reserves the right to change the itinerary due to unforeseen emergencies.

RESPONSIBILITIES:
