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**Monday, October 5 - Day 1 – DEPART** – Depart New York JFK airport for our overnight flight to Catania via Rome aboard a wide-bodied jet. Complementary beverages, in-flight movies, dinner and breakfast will be served aloft.

**Tuesday, October 6 - Day 2 – ARRIVE CATANIA** – Transfer to the hotel Catania. Remainder of day at our leisure. Dinner and overnight at our hotel.

**Wednesday, October 7 - Day 3 – ETNA/TAORMINA** - Mt. Etna is Sicily's tallest peak and one of Europe's most famous active volcanoes. The most violent eruption to take place in the XX century was in 1910, which led to twenty-three additional craters being formed. In 1928, a lava flow destroyed the village of Mascali. Lunch will take place in a nearby Farmhouse (Agriturismo). This afternoon



we visit Taormina, known in the ancient times as Tauromenion, is a spot of infinite loveliness, the land of "Dolce far Niente" - of sweet do nothing. The town lies in an elevated position of amazing, almost unique beauty, affording magnificent views of the sea and clear sky with miles of a curving coastline and picturesque mountain scenery, while the majestic pyramid of Mt. Etna on the other side constitutes a scene of indescribable beauty. Upon arrival, we visit the most impressive monument of the city: the Greco-Roman Theatre. It has the finest location of any theatre in the world and is one of the most striking monuments of antiquity. Return to our hotel for dinner and overnight.

**Thursday, October 8 - Day 4 – SANTA CROCE CAMERINA/RAGUSA** - Today we depart for Santa Croce Camerina we will enjoy a walking tour of the town stop for lunch (on our own) . This afternoon if time permits, we will stop in Ragusa on our way back to Catania. Dinner at a local restaurant and overnight at our hotel.

**Friday, October 9 - Day 5 – SIRACUSA** – This morning we drive to Siracusa. A city built on an ancient Greek settlement founded by Corinthians in 734 BC. It became the most important city in Magna Graecia and for a time competed with Athens as the most important city in the

Greek world. Siracusa expresses all the variety and cultural complexity of Sicily, spanning from the ancient times to today.

The visit includes: the Archaeological Park with the Greek Theatre (V century AC), where during the season the ancient Greek tragedies are performed; the Ara of Ierone; the Roman Anfiteatro, where the gladiator competitions occurred; the

Latomie of the Paradise, ancient hollow stones known for their different shapes, the most famous being the Orecchio of Dionisio. Some of the ancient sights to see in Syracuse are located in Ortigia, the most important being: the Cathedral – a Doric Temple built on a Sicilian settlement, Byzantine basilica, a Norman church, with late Renaissance and then Baroque elements - and the Arethusa Fountain, which is a

place linked to Greek mythology. Return to our hotel for dinner and overnight.

**Saturday, October 10 Day 6 –CATANIA/PALERMO** - Today we drive to Palermo with a stop along the way for lunch. This afternoon continue to our hotel, check-in remainder of day at our leisure. Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Palermo.

**Sunday, October 11 - Day 7 – CEFALÙ/FARMER'S LUNCH** - Today we visit Cefalu` a city boasting one of the most beautiful churches in Sicily. We proceed to the Castelbuono area, where we enjoy lunch at an Agriturismo. Return to our hotel for dinner and overnight. (Palermo)

**Monday, October 12 - Day 8 – MONREALE/PALERMO** - Departure for Morning visit of Monreale, visit its famous Cathedral built by the Normans over an ancient mosque. This afternoon we return to Palermo for a walking tour. Remainder of day at our leisure. Dinner at a local restaurant overnight at our hotel.

**Tuesday, October 13 - Day 9 - RETURN TO U.S. -** Today we make our way home, with memories that will last a lifetime!

**TOTAL TOUR PRICE:** The tour price is based on airfare, cruise, land rates and rates of exchange in effect May 9, 2019. All rates are subject to change without prior notice. Should the rates go up or down, an adjustment would be made prior to departure. Neither refunds can be granted for any accommodations, services or events that are not used nor if you deviate from the tour. If fewer than 20 passengers participate a price adjustment may be necessary.

**PASSPORT AND VISA REQUIREMENTS:** A valid passport is required. At the time of printing, U.S. citizens holding valid passports DO NOT REQUIRE visas or immunization for the country or countries being visited. Citizens of countries other than U.S. - please contact the consulate of the country or countries being visited to determine visa requirements.

**AIR TRANSPORTATION:** International flight reservations are being held on Alitalia Airlines. No stopovers are permitted. Any changes after ticket is issued, carries a mandatory charge of \$200. Once the tickets are issued, they are NON-REFUNDABLE. Additional non-recoverable airline penalties of up to \$200 may be assessed for cancellations received within 90 days of departure

**DOMESTIC AIRFARE:** For those who make domestic air arrangements to the originating city of this tour, your tour host and Unitours strongly recommend the purchase of tickets that can be changed without heavy fees and penalties as international flight schedules are always subject to change.

**HOTEL ACCOMMODATIONS:** Specially selected hotels based on twin occupancy with private bath. Single Room supplement of \$832 will be charged where requested and available. If you do not have a roommate and Unitours is unable to arrange one, you will be billed for the single room supplement. All singles are subject to availability.

**MEALS:** Breakfast and Table D' Hote dinners are provided daily except where noted in the itinerary. An extra charge will be made when coffee, tea or other beverages are not included in the menu of the day with the dinner meal.

apply for new reservations made after 45 days of departure.) Reservations made within 60 days of departure must include full payment. Amex, Discover, Visa and MasterCard are accepted with signed reservation form. Final payments will be applied to same credit card on final payment due date including insurance. Cancellations made from time of reservation to within 61 days prior to departure -- \$100 processing charge plus any air penalties noted above. In the event of a cancellation from 60 to 31 days of departure -- \$150 processing charge plus up to 50% of the land cost, plus any air penalties noted above. There can be no refund for any services for cancellations received within 30 days of departure. All cancellation and refund claims must be in writing to Unitours, Inc.
