Wednesday, Feb 17 - Day 1 -

DEPART – Today, we depart from New Orleans to connect with our overnight flight to Europe. We enjoy in-flight movies, dinner and breakfast aloft.

Thursday, Feb 18 - Day 2 –

MEDJUGORJE – This morning we arrive in Italy and connect to our flight to Dubrovnik. We are met by our guide and transferred to Medjugorje. Upon arrival in Medjugorje we go to our accommodation and are introduced to our host family. Light snack or dinner will be served depending on the time of arrival.

Friday, Feb 19 - Day 3 –

**MEDJUGORJE/MOSTAR/
MEDJUGORJE** - After breakfast, Holy Mass for English speaking pilgrims is at 10:00 a.m. in the church of St. James. Following Mass, we have an opening meeting and introduction at the shrine of Our Lady Queen of Peace. We listen to a talk by one of the Medjugorje priests on the messages of Our Lady. We visit Mostar. We return to Medjugorje for dinner and overnight. After dinner we participate in the evening program.

Saturday, Feb 20 - Day 3 –

MEDJUGORJE – After breakfast, we meet with our guides at the statue of Our Lady to walk through the vineyards, to the Hill of Apparitions (Podbrdo). We hear the story of the first days of the apparitions and then climb, in prayer, to the site of the first apparition. Here we celebrate our Mass.

There is usually a talk by one of the visionaries on the messages of Our Lady or a meeting with one of the parish priests. Dinner and overnight in Medjugorje. Evening prayer program in the church.

Sunday, Feb 21 - Day 5 –

MEDJUGORJE/SPLIT – Following our final Mass in Medjugorje, we depart over the mountains and again cross the border to Croatia. We stop in Makarska, center of the vacation area on the beautiful Croatian coast and enjoy free time for lunch on the promenade overlooking an idyllic bay. Continue along the spectacular Magistrale coast road to Split where we enjoy a short sightseeing tour including the 3rd century Diocletian Palace and Cathedral, formerly the Mausoleum of the Emperor Diocletian. We enjoy dinner near the port before boarding our overnight ferry to Ancona in Italy.

Monday, Feb 22 - Day 6 – ANCONA

/ASSISI – This morning, we arrive in Ancona where we are met and transferred to Assisi. Our first stop is in the lower town for a visit to the Basilica of St. Mary of the Angels, and the Portiuncula, Francis' Church of the Little Portion. We celebrate Mass here. After lunch on our own, we begin our walking tour of the Upper Village at the Basilica of St. Francesco with a visit to St. Francis Tomb. We visit the Church of St. Clare to view the crucifix that spoke to St. Francis. Finally, we visit the resting place of newly canonized in 2025 St. Carlo Acutis who was 15-years old when he died in 2006 from leukemia. Acutis' tomb is in Assisi's *Sanctuary of the Renunciation*, the spot where a young St.



Francis of Assisi cast off his rich clothes in favor of a poor habit. We continue to our hotel for dinner and overnight in Assisi.

Tuesday - Feb 23 - Day 7 – ASSISI/ROME - This morning, we depart Assisi and travel south to the Eternal City, Rome. After lunch on our own, we w tour the Basilica of St. Mary Major. St. Mary's holds relics of Christ's Holy Manger from Bethlehem and a piece of the true cross from Golgotha. The golden ceiling of St. Mary's is decorated by the first gold brought back from the New World by Christopher Columbus. The Spanish Catholic Kings—Ferdinand and Isabel—gave the gold as a gift to the Pope. We take time to pray at St. Mary's, the largest church dedicated to Mary in the west, built in the fifth century following the Council of Ephesus. We conclude our day at St. Sebastian's Catacombs, burial place of early Christians. We celebrate Mass here and view the relic of the arrow that wounded St. Sebastian and a cast of the footprints of Christ made famous in the Quo Vadis episode. Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Rome.

Wednesday, Feb 24 - Day 8 – ROME -- This morning, we make our way to St. Peter's for the Audience of Pope Leo XIV, if he is in residence. After lunch on our own, we visit the Vatican Museums which culminate in Michelangelo's Sistine Chapel. Afterwards, we view the treasures of St. Peter's Basilica including the *Pieta*, Bernini's "Window of the Holy Spirit" made from alabaster as well as his famous altar columns in St. Peter's. One altar column contains the spear of St. Longinus, which was on display earlier this year. St. Longinus, the Roman centurion who pierced the side of our Savior, was converted by the blood and water that flowed from Christ's Sacred Heart. We enjoy dinner with

entertainment out at a local restaurant tonight. Overnight at our hotel in Rome.
Thursday, Feb 25 - Day 9 – RETURN TO USA – We transfer to the airport for our return flight to the U.S with unforgettable memories to cherish always.

TOTAL TOUR PRICE: The tour price is based on airfare, cruise, land rates and rates of exchange in effect April 27, 2026. All rates are subject to change without prior notice. Should the rates go up or down, an adjustment would be made prior to departure. Refunds CANNOT be granted for any accommodations, services or events that are not used nor if you deviate from the tour. If fewer than 30 pilgrims participate a price adjustment may be necessary.

PASSPORT AND VISA REQUIREMENTS: A valid passport is required. At the time of printing, U.S. citizens holding valid passports DO NOT REQUIRE visas. Passport MUST be valid until August 25, 2027, or later. Citizens of countries other than U.S. - please contact the consulate of the country or countries being visited to determine visa requirements.

AIR TRANSPORTATION: International flight reservations are being held on American & Croatian Airlines. No stopovers are permitted. Any changes after ticket is issued carries a mandatory charge of \$200. Once the tickets are issued, they are NON-TRANSFERABLE AND NON-REFUNDABLE. Any requests to change a ticket once issued will incur a reissue fee of \$200 plus any fare differential will apply. Cancellation of air seat within 90 days of departure will incur a \$200 penalty.

DOMESTIC AIRFARE: For those who make domestic air arrangements to the originating city of this tour, your tour host and Unitours strongly recommend the purchase of tickets that can be changed without heavy fees and penalties as international flight schedules are always subject to change.

HOTEL ACCOMMODATIONS: Specially selected hotels based on twin occupancy with private bath. Single Room supplement of \$524 will be charged where requested and available. If you do not have a roommate and Unitours is unable to arrange one, you will be billed for the single room supplement. All singles are subject to availability.

MEALS: Breakfast and Table D' Hote dinners are provided daily except where noted in the itinerary. An extra charge will be made when coffee, tea or other beverages are not included in the menu of the day with the dinner meal.

TIPS AND TAXES: Tips and taxes normally appearing on hotel and restaurant bills as service are included, as are all government and local taxes on hotels and meals, portage of one suitcase per person. International departure taxes of \$190 plus current fuel surcharges of \$590 are included (subject to change). TIPS TO TOUR MANAGER/GUIDES, DRIVERS OR DINING ROOMS STAFF OF \$88 ARE NOT INCLUDED. One average sized suitcase not exceeding 50 lbs total weight and 62 linear inches (height plus width plus depth) is permitted throughout the trip.

NOT INCLUDED: Expenses and items not specifically mentioned in this brochure are NOT covered, including but not limited to: passport and visa fees, meals not listed and items of a personal nature such as laundry, wines, liquors, mineral waters, after dinner coffee or tea, sightseeing or services other than those specifically mentioned, tips and taxes mentioned above, excess baggage and insurance, etc.

DEPOSITS AND CANCELLATIONS: A deposit of \$500 is required to secure reservations. Any balance is to be paid in full no later than 60 days before departure of tour. Final payments received at Unitours after 45 days before departure must include a \$25 late payment fee. (This does not apply for new reservations made after

45 days of departure.) Reservations made within 60 days of departure must include full payment. Amex, Discover, Visa and MasterCard are accepted with signed reservation form. Final payments will be applied to same credit card on final payment due date. Cancellations made from time of reservation to within 61 days prior to departure - - \$400 administration fee (charged to deposit) plus any air penalties noted above. In the event of a cancellation from 60 to 31 days prior to departure - - \$400 administration fee plus up to 50% of the land cost, plus any air penalties noted above. No refund for cancellations received within 30 days of departure. All cancellation and refund claims must be in writing to Unitours, Inc.

BANK FEE: A fee of \$50 will be charged for any check that is returned to us for insufficient or unavailable funds.

DEVIATIONS: A service charge of \$50 pp will be applied for any deviations made in tour, (where possible), PLUS any additional air or land charges incurred.
