## Thursday, Sep 12 - Day 1 - DEPART USA

Today our pilgrimage begins! We depart New York or Chicago for France, on our transatlantic flight, aboard a wide-bodied jet. We enjoy in-flight movies, dinner and breakfast aloft.

## Friday, Sep 13 - Day 2 – LOURDES

This afternoon we arrive in Lourdes. After checking into our hotel, walking distance from the grotto, we enjoy free time to acclimate to the time change. In the early evening, we join the Rosary and candlelight procession. Overnight and dinner at our hotel in Lourdes.

## Saturday, Sep 14 - Day 3 – LOURDES

Today is a leisurely day in the special town of Lourdes. We celebrate Mass at the grotto, the very place where the Virgin appeared to Bernadette. We enjoy an orientation visit to the Shrine and a walking tour. We visit Boly Mill, where St. Bernadette was born, the Cachot, her simple house where she lived during the apparitions, and the parish church. We enjoy the opportunity to experience the healing waters of the miraculous Lourdes spring, then walk the stations of the cross. In the early evening, we join the Rosary and candlelight procession. Overnight and dinner at our hotel in Lourdes.

## Sunday, Sep 15 - Day 4 – PARAY LE MONIAL

This morning, after breakfast, we journey north to Paray le Monial, known as the City of the Eucharist, and visit the site of the Shrine of the Sacred Heart of Jesus and Saint Margaret Mary Alacoque. Here we stop in the Chapel of the Visitation where she famously received the visions of the Sacred Heart. Dinner and overnight at our hotel in this region.

## Monday, Sep 16 - Day 5 – NEVERS/PARIS

Today we visit the convent of St. Gildard, where Bernadette Soubirous of Lourdes spent the final 13 years of her life. Here we see her incorrupt body kept in a glass reliquary. We enjoy a guided tour of Nevers before continuing to Paris. As we drive into the Illuminated City, our first stop is Sacré Coeur, located at the summit of Montmartre, the highest point in Paris. The spectacular view of the city will take our breath away. We then tour her sights passing the Eiffel Tower, the Arc de Triomphe and travel down the famous Champs-Elysees. Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Paris.

## Tuesday, Sep 17 - Day 6 – PARIS

After an early breakfast at our hotel, we celebrate Mass at the chapel of Our Lady of the Miraculous Medal on the Rue de Bac, where the Virgin Mary appeared to St. Catherine Laboure and gave her instructions to make the Miraculous Medal, the most famous Catholic medal in circulation. The shrine contains the saint's incorrupt body. We will also see the site where the Blessed Mother famously first appeared on January 28, 1840 to Sister Justine Bisqueyburu of the Daughters of Charity before revealing to her the Green Scapular. We walk around the corner to the Shrine of St. Vincent de Paul, at the Church of St. Lazare, where his body rests and his incorrupt heart is displayed in a reliquary. He was a shining example of love for the poor. Our





last stop today will be the famous Notre Dame cathedral, the most enduring symbol of the French capital, on the Ile de la Cité. Time permitting, we continue to Sainte-Chapelle, the royal chapel, constructed in a Gothic style. Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Paris.

**Wednesday, Sep 18 - Day 7 – PARIS – FREE DAY or optional *Pontmain excursion***

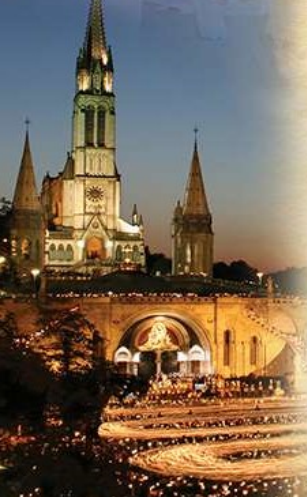
Today pilgrims have the option of a free day in Paris or if there is enough interest, an *optional* day trip will be offered to **Pontmain**, Our Lady of **Pontmain**, also know as Our Lady of Hope is the title give to the Virgin Mary on her apparition at **Pontmain**, France on 17 January 1871. Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Paris.

**Thursday, Sep 19 - Day 8 – BRUSSELS**

After breakfast, we will head into French-speaking Belgium, for the final leg of our pilgrimage. Our quest is to see two of the only four Vatican recognized 20<sup>th</sup> century Marian apparitions in the world. First, we stop in Beauraing, where the Blessed Virgin appeared 33 times starting in 1932 as the “Virgin of the Golden Heart” to 5 children aged 9 to 15. The Mother of God called for prayer for the conversion of sinners. We continue to Banneaux, where “Our Lady of the Poor” is the sobriquet given to the apparition of the Virgin Mary to 11-year old Mariette Beco in a garden behind the family’s cottage. The Virgin Mary here promised to intercede for the poor, the sick and the suffering. We visit the sacred spring, the Chapel of the Apparitions, and celebrate Mass. We celebrate our pilgrimage with wine at our final dinner. Overnight at our hotel.

**Friday, Sep 20 - Day 9 – BRUSSELS**

This morning we will visit St. Michael and St. Gudula Cathedral, in Brussels, the capital of Belgium. This is the site of a verified Eucharistic Miracle in 1370. The Cathedral contains artistic testimonies in the form of stained glass that tell the story. We will celebrate our final Mass here as we conclude our extraordinary pilgrimage. Time permitting, we will enjoy a short driving tour of Brussels as we head to the airport and board our flight back to the U.S. via Paris arriving later today. The memories of our spectacular pilgrimage will stay with us forever.

**TOTAL TOUR PRICE:** The tour price is based on airfare, cruise, land rates and rates of exchange in effect November 14, 2018. All rates are subject to change without prior notice. Should the rates go up or down, an adjustment would be made prior to departure. Refunds CANNOT be granted for any accommodations, services or events that are not used nor if you deviate from the tour. If fewer than 35 pilgrims participate a price adjustment may be necessary.

**PASSPORT AND VISA REQUIREMENTS:** A valid passport is required. At the time of printing, U.S. citizens holding valid passports DO NOT REQUIRE visas or immunization for the country or countries being visited. Passport MUST be valid until **March 20, 2020** or later. Citizens of countries other than U.S. - please contact the consulate of the country or countries being visited to determine visa requirements.

**AIR TRANSPORTATION:** International flight reservations are being held on Air France and KLM Airlines. No stopovers are permitted. Any changes after ticket is issued, carries a mandatory charge of \$200. Once the tickets are issued, they are NON-TRANSFERABLE AND NON-REFUNDABLE. Any requests to change a ticket once issued will incur a reissue fee of \$200 plus any fare differential will apply. Cancellation of air seat within 90 days of departure will incur a \$200 penalty.

**DOMESTIC AIRFARE:** For those who make domestic air arrangements to the originating city of this tour, your tour host and Unitours strongly recommend the purchase of tickets that can be changed without heavy fees and penalties as international flight schedules are always subject to change.

**HOTEL ACCOMMODATIONS:** Specially selected hotels based on twin occupancy with private bath. Single Room supplement of \$771 will be charged where requested and available. If you do not have a roommate and Unitours is unable to arrange one, you will be billed for the single room supplement. All singles are subject to availability.

**MEALS:** Breakfast and Table D' Hote dinners are provided daily except where noted in the itinerary. An extra charge will be made when coffee, tea or other beverages are not included in the menu of the day with the dinner meal. **TIPS AND TAXES:** Tips and taxes normally appearing on hotel and restaurant bills as service are included, as are all government and local taxes on hotels and meals, portage of one suitcase per person. International departure taxes of \$143 plus current fuel surcharges of \$350 are included (subject to change). **TIPS TO TOUR MANAGER/GUIDES, DRIVERS OR DINING ROOMS STAFF OF \$80 ARE NOT INCLUDED.** One average sized suitcase not exceeding 50 lbs total weight and 62 linear inches (height plus width plus depth) is permitted throughout the trip.

**NOT INCLUDED:** Expenses and items not specifically mentioned in this brochure are NOT covered, including but not limited to: passport and visa fees, meals not listed and items of a personal nature such as laundry, wines, liquors, mineral waters, after dinner coffee or tea, sightseeing or services other than those specifically mentioned, tips and taxes mentioned above, excess baggage and insurance, etc. **DEPOSITS AND CANCELLATIONS:** A deposit of \$500 is required to secure reservations. Any balance is to be paid in full no later than 60 days before departure of tour. Final payments received at Unitours after 45 days before departure must include a \$25 late payment fee. (This does not apply for new reservations made after 45 days of departure.) Reservations made within 60 days of departure must include full payment. Amex, Discover, Visa and MasterCard are accepted with signed reservation form. Final payments will be applied to same credit card on final payment due date including insurance. Cancellations made from time of reservation to within 61 days prior to departure -- \$100 processing charge plus any air penalties noted above. In the event of a cancellation from 60 to 31 days of departure -- \$150 processing charge plus up to 50% of the land cost, plus any air penalties noted above. There can be no refund for any services for cancellations received within 30 days of departure. All cancellation and refund claims must be in writing to Unitours, Inc.

**BANK FEE:** A fee of \$50 will be charged for any check that is returned to us for insufficient or unavailable funds.

**DEVIATIONS:** A service charge of \$50 pp will be applied for any deviations made in tour, (where possible), PLUS any additional air or land charges incurred.
